Accessibility

Wheelchair accessible	All buildings are accessible for wheelchairs and buggies. Most buildings have automatic main doors at the entrance and all buildings with additional floors have lifts available.
Parking availability information	Drop off facilities are available next to Fleet building where the college's main reception area is situated. Disability bays are available close to all buildings. A main college car park is available for all other vehicles.
Toilet facility information	All buildings have accessible toilets with electric or manual hoists available. Two toilets are fitted with Closomat toilets (integrated washing and drying). Accessible changing beds are available for any students needing support with personal care.
Other Facilities	Electric and manual hoists, accessible changing beds, quiet garden. We have a medical and personal care assistant who can administer medication to students that need support taking their medication whilst on the college campus. Support is available for students requiring help with personal care or feeding.
