Victoria Gardens in Portland is the grassed and formal bedding areas are a focal point as you enter the island. A large rockery running across the centre of the gardens is planted with a mixture of shrubs, perennials and bedding plants. There is a small fenced play area with equipment suitable for children, aged from 2 to 8 years is positioned at the upper tier of the gardens. There are also 2 tennis courts and a bowling green.
